## Cricket Champions

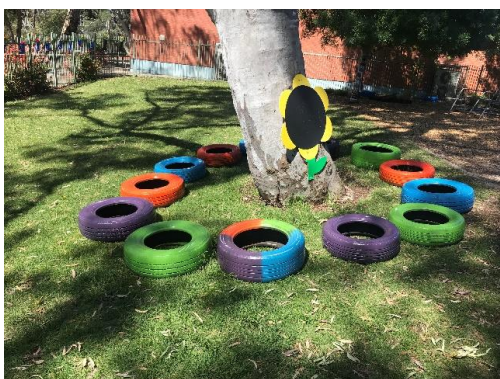

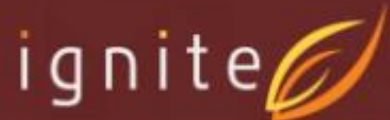

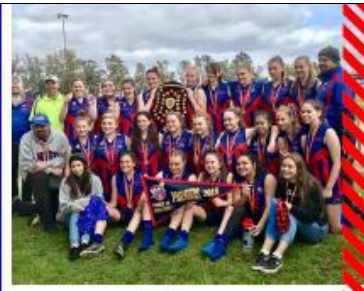
